Dear Parents and Caregivers,

We have a very excited group of Year Six children as they do their final preparations for Camp next week. They will be leaving on the train early Monday morning travelling to Perth for a week's adventure staying at Woodman Point. Mrs Sullivan and Miss Byrd have worked extremely hard organising the Camp amid all the uncertainties COVID presented this year. Mrs Gorman and Mrs Altus will be attending the camp with the Year Six teachers, also attending are four parent helpers and Fr Jeffey. We know they will all have a wonderful time.

Kindy Interviews are continuing this week. It is lovely to be able to welcome prospective parents into our school and show them the wonderful things that are happening in the classrooms and around our school. If you know of anyone who is intending to enrol in Kindy in 2023 and has not yet put their application in to the school, please let them know places are filling quickly.

On Wednesday, the 26th October the Year Three Catholic children and their parents will take part in a compulsory workshop about the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Year One students are participating in a SciTech incursion on Friday. I know they will enjoy all the hands-on activities.

In the afternoon, for the smooth running of the pick-up line it is very important for safety and to manage the numbers for everyone to queue and drive through the double gates to pick up in the supervised area provided. This has been our process for many years and we find it is the safest solution.

MANDATE LETTER - NEW EVANGELISATION IN CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Jesus is present in liturgical celebrations—especially the Eucharist. Students need to be reminded frequently that it is Jesus himself who acts in his sacraments and liturgies of the Word, including their celebration in the Catholic school. Liturgies are his prayer, in which each member of the school community is invited to participate actively, internally within their hearts as well as externally, by placing before God their personal prayers. Jesus makes these prayers his own so that they take on the infinite power of the Son of God praying to God the Father.

In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells us how important it is to be very simple and honest when we pray. We do not need to pretend with God, because God does not compare us with other people. This Sunday 23 October is also Mission Sunday, a day set aside by all Catholic churches throughout the world to renew its commitment to the missionary movement.

GOSPEL

Listen to the Gospel according to Luke 18: 9 – 14

Jesus told a story to some people who thought they were better than others and who looked down on everyone else. "Two men went into the temple to pray. One was a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood over by himself and prayed, 'God I thank you that I am not greedy dishonest and unfaithful in marriage like other people. And I am really glad that I am not like the tax collector over there. I go without eating for two days a week, and I give you one tenth of all I earn.' The tax collector stood off at a distance and did not think he was good enough even to look up toward heaven. He was so sorry for what he had done that he pounded on his chest and prayed. 'God, have pity on me! I am such a sinner.'





