## MANDATE LETTER - NEW EVANGELISATION IN CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Catholic schools need also to help students who are already aware of the sacred to deepen this sense within themselves. In particular, this means helping them to respond to sense of the presence of Jesus Christ, especially within the school. Students and staff need to appreciate that he is present within each baptised person, such as when the school community gathers in his name. He is present, too, in the Word of God in whatever way it is being celebrated and in every person in need.

This Sunday is the Twenty Ninth Sunday of Ordinary time. In Luke's Gospel it reflects upon that people sometimes get tired of children asking for things. Teachers and students get tired of the same old lessons. We sometimes get tired of friends who borrow our things. In the reading, Jesus tells us that God never gets tired of us. God is the one who will never say. "Stop bothering me!"

### GOSPEL

Listen to the words of the Gospel of Luke  
18: 1-8

Jesus told his disciples a story about how they should keep on praying and never give up. In a town there was once a judge who didn't fear God or care about people. In the same town there was a widow who kept going to the judge and saying, "Make sure that I get fair treatment in court." For a while the judge refused to do anything. Finally, he said to himself, "Even though I don't fear God or care about people, I will help this widow because she keeps on bothering me. If I don't help her she will wear me out." The Lord said, "Think about what that crooked judge said. Won't God protect his chosen ones who pray to him day and night? Won't he be concerned for them? He will surely hurry and help them."

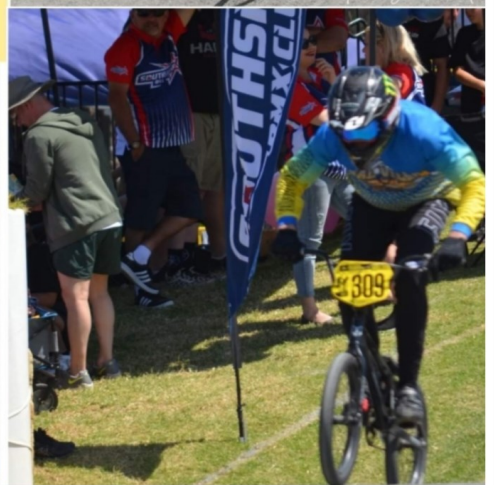

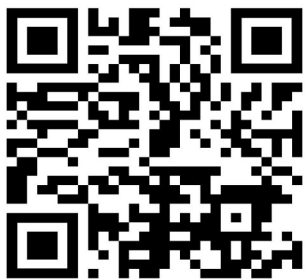
