MANDATE LETTER - PRIMARY PROCLAMATION

He revealed its power first through his miracles of healing, casting out demons, freeing cripples to walk, and giving sight to the blind, hearing to the deaf and speech to the mute. Then he forgave sins and raised the dead.

God's greatest demonstration of the power of the Kingdom was the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. From this his disciples realised that, since he could conquer death, the greatest of all human limitations, no human sin, weakness or failing was beyond Christ's power. It continually recreates and renews human beings.

This Sunday is the Feast of Pentecost, a great day in our Christian year. It is the fiftieth day of Easter. On this day we rejoice that Jesus keeps his promises. He promised that he would send the Holy Spirit to unify and strengthen his followers, and he did just that. Today's reading tells us how.

READING

Listen to the words of the Acts of the Apostles: 2:1-4, 6-7,11

On the day of the Pentecost all the Lord's followers were together in one place. Suddenly there was a noise from heaven like the sound of a mighty wind! It filled the house where they were meeting. Then they saw what looked like fiery tongues moving in all directions, and a tongue came and settled on each person there. The Holy Spirit let them speak.

When they heard this noise, a crowd gathered. But they were surprised, because they were hearing everything in their own languages. They were excited and amazed, and said, "Don't all these who are speaking come from Galilee? Yet we all hear them using our own languages to tell the wonderful things God has done."

that I love but what is holy;

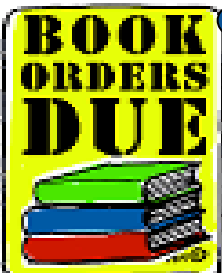
Strengthen me O Holy Spirit to
